Anil Trigunayat has been a professional Indian diplomat for over three decades serving India's national interests across continents from Asia to Africa to Europe and Americas including Russia and USA. Prior to his superannuation in 2016 he served as India's Ambassador to Jordan, Libya and Malta. He has studied in prestigious universities including Jawaharlal Nehru University and Oxford University. He is a regular commentator on foreign affairs and a prolific writer. Currently, apart from his association with various think-tanks, strategy groups and the chambers of commerce and industries, he is a Distinguished Fellow at Vivekananda International Foundation, heading their West Asia Experts Group. His key areas of interest include West Asia, Africa, and Russia. Recently Government has appointed him as an Independent Director on the Board of WAPCOS, a mini-Ratna Government Company. Apart from penning scores of articles, opinion pieces and commentaries on foreign policy issues in leading magazines and newspapers he has recently edited a book on “Evolving Security Dynamic in West Asia and India’s Challenges”, published by VIF and Pentagon Press.
